Hello,

I'd like to make you aware of an eventual change related to our Gas and Electrical Inspections area. On December 13, 2018, the Government of Saskatchewan announced the decision to move SaskPower's Gas and Electrical Inspections Division to the Technical Safety Authority of Saskatchewan (TSASK). This transition will take time, with the official move anticipated to happen in the fall of 2020.

The Technical Safety Authority of Saskatchewan is an independent regulatory body that has demonstrated its ability to deliver quality, client-centred services to industry and the people of Saskatchewan. Having the province's gas and electrical inspectors operate within an independent, regulatory body will create efficiencies and better customer service. This is the case in other provinces such as British Columbia and Ontario.

I'd like to reinforce that throughout this transition, our team will maintain an unwavering focus on serving Saskatchewan by ensuring gas and electrical work in the province is safe and up to standard. This work is – and will remain – a very important part of keeping Saskatchewan residents safe at work, at home and throughout their communities.
